- By pushing valves
- By moving slides
- By changing harmonic notes

4. Name some lip-blown instruments that are used in bands and orchestras today. (4 points)

- Trumpet
- Trombone
- French Horn
- Tuba

5. Name some lip-blown instruments that were used by people from the past (2000+ years ago). (4 points)

- *Shofar* (Ram's horn)
- Conch trumpet (shell)
- Stick Trumpet (*Didjeridu*)
- Egyptian *Snb*
